The Scrum Team and its stakeholders agree to be open about all the work and the challenges with performing the work.



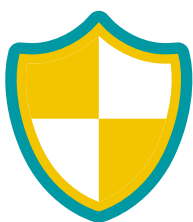
Scrum Team members respect each other to be capable, independent people. As a part of the Scrum team, you should respect colleagues, their decisions, and their experience.
